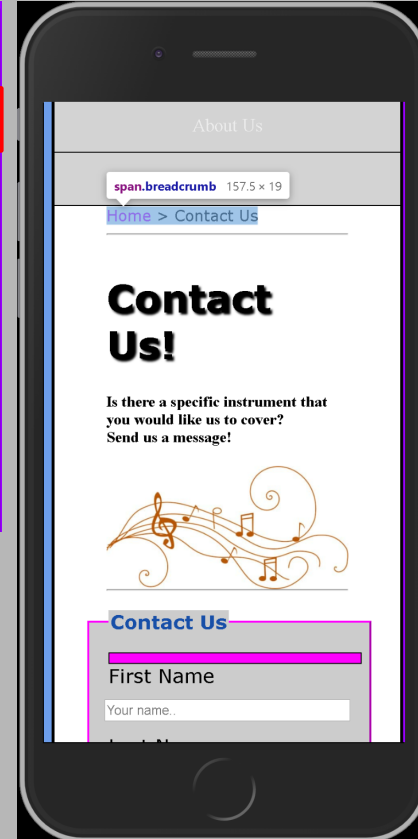
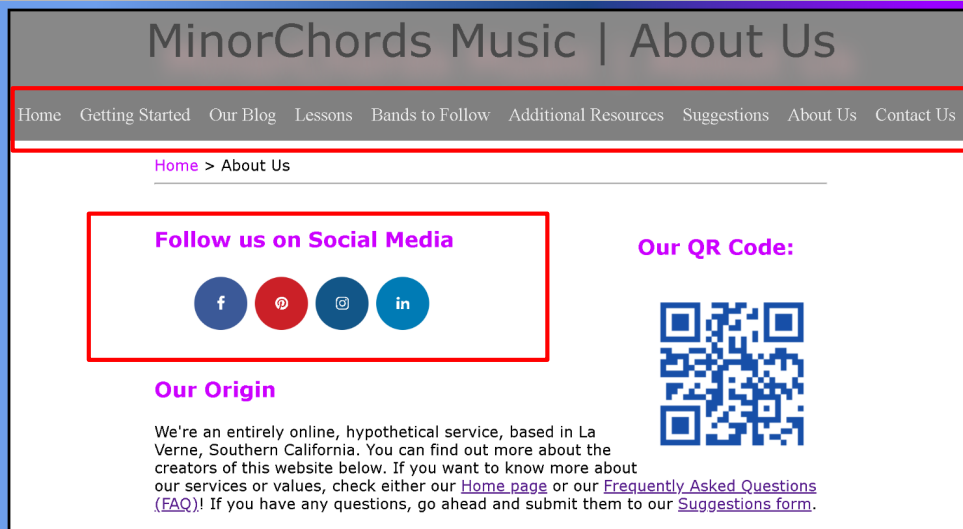
Dinosaur Jr.
