

I would like to give you some info on **HOP (Hands-on Practice) grading policy**.

All chapter **HOPs count 10 points**. HOPs for chapter 8 and 9 combined count 10 points as well.

- **Include** the Mozilla Firefox **output** and the corresponding HOP **code** together, at least two HOPs per word doc page.
- **Highlight** the new **key component/attributes** of each HOP. See examples: **2\_HOP\_Ch2\_screenshots\_TEMPLATE.docx**
- If a HOP includes a footer, put your email address at the footer.
