Some veterinarians warn that insufficient moisture in the diet may increase the risk of crystals, or stones in the urinary tract. An ample volume of urine is necessary to dilute solid materials that could otherwise accumulate and form stones. Stones can cause painful, sometimes even life-threatening urinary tract blockages. Regardless of age, any time your pet shows a sign of illness, such as those listed below, bring them to the veterinarian as soon as possible.

- Coughing, sneezing, runny nose
- Greater or diminished eating, drinking, urination, defecation
- Frequent vomiting
- Howling
- Excessive licking
- Increase or decrease in activity, grooming, sleeping
- Bald spots
- Weight loss
- Avoiding the litter box

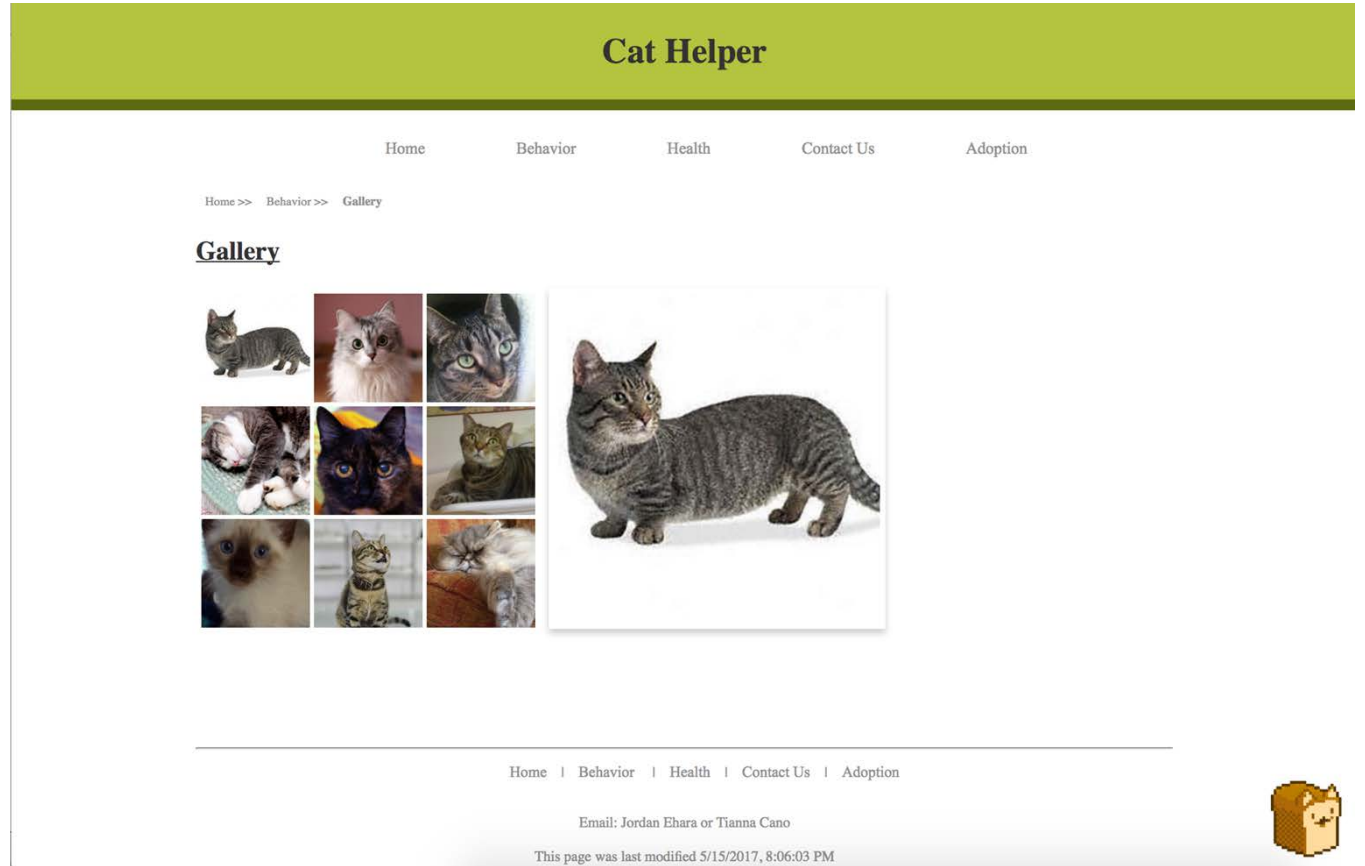

Keeping Up With Your Cat's Hygiene Is Very Important!

▼ Bathing your cat can be difficult. Here are some helpful tips on how to keep your kitty clean!

- For cats with long hair it is recommended to comb their fur before giving them a bath.
- Choose a shampoo specially made for cats. Some shampoos are concentrated and need to be diluted
- Keep a mat or screen for the bottom of the tub or sink so that your cat may have something to cling to.
- Use warm water, and it is recommended to use a sprayer or cup for rinsing.
- Keep a firm grip on the neck scruff as you bathe your cat.
- You can use a hairdryer set on low or cool to dry off your feline friend.

▼ Taking care of your cat's teeth can be tough. Here are some helpful tips on how to maintain your cat's pearly whites!

- Brush cat's teeth several times a week to prevent plaque, tartar, periodontal disease.
- There are pet specific dentifrice with flavors cats like such as poultry and seafood.
- There are toothbrushes for cats. It is recommended to use those rather than toothbrushes meant for people.
- Chlorhexidine is the most effective anti-plaque antiseptic. Chlorhexidine binds to the oral tissues and tooth surfaces, and is gradually released into the oral cavity. Chlorhexidine oral rinses or gels are safe for pets and rarely cause problems.
- Dental chew products for cats include a kibble design and others include a chemical anti-tartar poly-phosphate ingredient.

▼ Maintaining your cat's claws is important. Here are some helpful tips on how to upkeep with your kittie's claws!

- Cats can be declawed but it is painful for cats and many veterinarians refuse to do such surgeries on cats.
- You can give your cat weekly claw pedicures. It's recommended you start these when your cat is a kitten so that they may get used to having their paws handled.
- Spend some time getting your cat used to having their paws handled before trimming.
- Use a nail clipper made for cats, and be sure the blades are sharp for a clean cut—dull blades crush the nail. Nail clippers come in two styles, guillotine and scissor.
- If your cat isn't willing to be very still during the process, try wrapping her snugly in a towel, freeing just one paw at a time.
- Inside each claw is the quick, the live center full of blood and nerves. If you cut the claw too short and hit the quick, your cat will bleed and experience pain, which will make them less than eager for the next trimming. Fortunately, most cats' claws lack pigment, so you can see the quick, especially if you hold the paw so there's light behind it. The quick will appear darker than the rest of the nail and sometimes has a pink tinge.
- Trim all claws on the front feet, including the dew claws. Rear claws don't need to be trimmed as often, if ever. They aren't as sharp as the front ones, and they grow more slowly.
- Another alternative is soft plastic covers applied to your cat's claws about once a month. Your vet or a groomer can apply them, or you can do it yourself. Claw covers can be useful for preventing destructive scratching while training or retraining appropriate behavior. A set lasts about a month, and if they're properly applied, your cat won't be able to remove them.

Food for Kittens
It is important to feed your pet a kitten formula up to one year. Kittens grow and develop every day. They require a food that meets the high-energy demands of their bodies. As your kitten becomes an adult cat, you may need to adjust their diet. You should begin slowly transitioning your kitten to adult food when they are one year old, or when your veterinarian recommends doing so. Spread out the transition process over a 7 to 10 day period, gradually increasing the amount of their new food each day. Kittens should follow a diet that is higher in protein and calories to meet their growth requirements without consuming excess.

Food for Adult Cats
For adult cats, it's important to remember that an "all life stage" cat food may seem like a good idea, but may have an adverse effect for some adult and senior cats due to excess nutrients.

Nutrition
How much a cat should eat depends on many variables including his activity level, metabolic rate and the food you are offering. Use the feeding guide on the cat food label as a starting point. These instructions usually read something like, "for cats weighing 5 lbs, feed between 1/2 and 3/4 cup per day; for cats weighing 10 lbs, feed between 3/4 and 1 cup per day; and for cats weighing 15 lbs, feed between 1 cup and 1 1/2 cups per day".
Five nutrient categories are included in nutritionally complete cat foods: proteins, carbohydrates, fats/oils, vitamins, and minerals. Veterinary nutritionists use a variety of ingredients to precisely balance the proportion of each nutrient category in relation to the others. For cats, too much of a nutrient can be just as dangerous as too little. A sixth nutrient, water, is also essential for feline health. Some water is included in all pet foods, and cats get the rest of what they need from the water bowl. Make sure your cat has access to fresh, clean water at all times.
